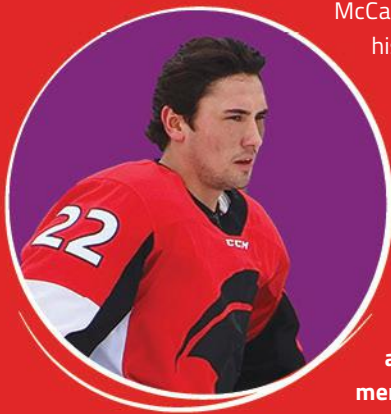


Ever considered a career in **engineering technologies**? This diverse field pulls together a passion for innovative problem-solving with a technical mind.

After graduating, I feel like I’m equipped for everything I need for any job in GIS.”** Starting this spring, that job is updating maps and databases for the county of Lac St. Anne, a municipal district just west of Edmonton. It’s work that he says marries his interests and skills.

Ronnie attributes his ability to secure a job right out of school to SAIT’s unique, industry-relevant programming and the seasoned instructors teaching hands-on skills in small classes. **“The way they teach at SAIT, it’s really practical. You know what you need. You know you’re going to use what you’re learning,”** he says. He adds the second-year practicum was a major reason why he was able to launch a career right from graduation and pursue his dream in Lac St. Anne.

Samonte also recognized opportunities came outside of the classroom. Serving as president of the BGIS club. Through the club, he was able to organize industry nights for students which he and others used to network, ultimately translating those introductions into work in his field.

INSTRUCTOR STORY

A one-time science teacher who later got a degree in optometry, **Larisia Hladun** has merged her passions for education and eye care as an instructor at SAIT. Using her expertise in both areas, Hladun helped develop curriculum and content for the institution's two new eye-focused programs, the Optician diploma and the Ophthalmic and Optometric Assisting certificate, which graduated its first set of students in April.

The Assisting certificate is the first of its kind in Alberta — in the past, employers hired people without any eye-care background, Hladun says. **"Many students were hired right out of their practicum. Employers were impressed with their base knowledge,"** she says. "It will change the standard of hiring."

Both programs start together by teaching students a base knowledge of anatomy and theory before splitting into the two individual programs. At that point, students are broken into smaller groups for labs, featuring hands-on learning with the latest equipment used in industry. **"There is a lot of instructor attention for building skills,"** Hladun says of the small class sizes.
